

In accordance with the State of Illinois' Tier 3 Resurgence Mitigations, the Oakbrook Terrace Park District has made changes to its operations. These changes are effective beginning Friday, November 20, 2020. Below are the details for specific areas of interest:

- **LEAP – Learn, Explore & Play:** Because LEAP is a remote learning program, we will continue to operate the program during Tier 3 of the State of Illinois' Resurgence Mitigation Plan as long as program minimums are met. LEAP incorporates groups of 10 people or less, increased sanitation practices, face coverings, and social distancing restrictions in accordance with Illinois Department of Public Health and CDC guidelines. There are a limited number of spaces available and pre-registration is required.
- **Nature Programs:** Nature programs, including small group bookings, will be suspended through at least Sunday, December 6th. We will re-evaluate the viability of running programs scheduled to take place Monday, December 7th and later as the date approaches.
- **Fall Programs:** All in-person recreation programs, including group exercise classes, have been cancelled through at least Sunday, December 6th. We will re-evaluate the viability of running programs scheduled to take place Monday, December 7th and later as the date approaches. All virtual programs will run as scheduled.
- **Heritage Center:** The Heritage Center is closed to the public until further notice. The Park District will continue to monitor resurgence mitigations and make changes when possible.
- **Fitness Center:** The Fitness Center will be closed until further notice. This closure includes the suspension of group exercise classes, personal training and rentals. The Park District will continue to monitor resurgence mitigations and make changes when possible.
- **Lake View Nature Center:** The Lake View Nature Center is closed to the public until further notice. This includes registered programs, small group bookings, and Nature Center Open Houses. The Park District will continue to monitor resurgence mitigations and make changes when possible.

- **Athletic Fields and Courts:** The outdoor tennis courts and sand volleyball courts at Heritage Park are closed for the season. The softball field at Terrace View Park and basketball courts at Heritage Park are open for passive recreation use. Usage is limited to 10 people or less at one time. Please follow social distancing guidelines, wear face coverings, and abide by all other applicable Illinois Department of Public Health guidance.
- **Parks and Playgrounds:** Parks remain open and will continue to remain open for walking, jogging, and biking as long as social distancing guidelines are followed. Playgrounds at Heritage Park and Terrace View Park will also be open. Playground capacity is limited to no more than 10 people. Please follow social distancing guidelines, wear face coverings, and abide by all other applicable Illinois Department of Public Health guidance. Playgrounds are not being sanitized.
- **Rentals:** Rentals have been suspended until further notice. No additional rentals will be accepted for the month of December. The Park District will continue to monitor resurgence mitigations and make changes when possible.
- **Special Events:** We are currently evaluating the viability of fall special events, including Drive-Thru Pancakes & Pics with Santa. All special event updates will be posted on the Park District's website and Facebook page.
- **Winter Brochure:** The winter brochure will be made available online only in late November.
